Loh Yi Ning is a classical pianist who is particularly interested in the areas of collaboration and education; she is an experienced performer in both the instrumental and vocal genres. Yi Ning graduated from NAFA with a Diploma in Music Performance (Classical Piano) in 2018 where she studied with Dr. Christina Tan.
